PRINCIPAL MESSAGE-----

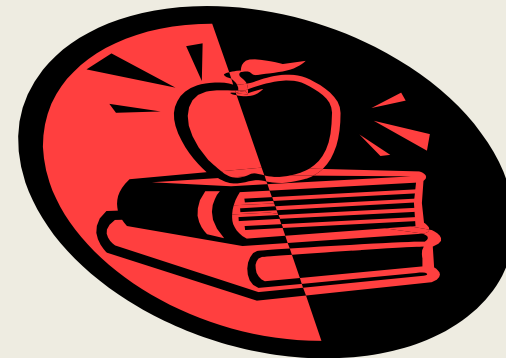
